2 California Department of Public Health - The Children and Youth with Special Health Care
3 Needs (CYSHCN) Innovation Grants - \$1,352,610]

4 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
5 **expend a grant in the amount of \$1,352,610 from the Health Resources and Services**
6 **Administration through the California Department of Public Health for participation in a**
7 **program, entitled “The Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs (CYSHCN)**
8 **Innovation Grants,” for the period of February 1, 2022, through June 30, 2025.**

10 WHEREAS, The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), through the
11 California Department of Public Health (CDPH) as a pass-through entity, has agreed to fund
12 the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$1,352,610 for participation in a
13 program, entitled “The Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs (CYSHCN)
14 Innovation Grants,” for the period of February 1, 2022, through June 30, 2025; and

15 WHEREAS, The Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health (MCAH) San Francisco
16 proposes to create an inter-agency council that brings together the community agencies that
17 serve CYSHCN, to be coordinated by community-based organization Support for Families of
18 Children with Disabilities (SFCD); and

19 WHEREAS, Having a common council will break down community silos and build a
20 system, and create a direct line of communication between families and the agencies serving
21 them to leave a greater, positive longitudinal impact on children, youth and families; and

22 WHEREAS, The Title V Action plan strategies aligns with our proposal to build data
23 capacity to understand needs and health disparities in the CYSHCN population; identify and
24 incorporate best practices to ensure CYSHCN and their families receive support for a
25 successful transition to adult healthcare, and train and engage CYSHCN and families to

1 improve CYSHCN-serving systems through input and involvement in state and local MCAH
2 program design, implementation and evaluation; and

3 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

4 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received
5 the letter of intent to award on January 28, 2022, for a project start date of February 1, 2022;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
8 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
10 the grant budget; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant
12 in the amount of \$1,352,610 from the HRSA through CDPH; and, be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
14 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
16 Agreement on behalf of the City.


