

# SFUSD Provides:

- Public access to 45 schoolyards by 9AM 4PM every Saturday, Sunday and most Holidays
- Well-maintained and landscaped properties (watering, weeding, and pruning) to the public
- Custodial services after every use (pick up debris, blow leaves)
- Maintenance staff to address all repair and maintenance needs
- Oversight of all partnerships, contracts, maintenance needs, outreach, programming, and events
- Docent and cleaning supplies, sports equipment, permits and insurance



# Milestones





#### **Milestones**

- Streamlined process for schoolyard improvement,
   community event grants and programming
- Formalized gate operations to minimize closures
- Launched a docent program creating job opportunities for SF residents
- Developed Social Media platforms and an official website and hired high school interns
- Launched the 2.0 Experience in 2020
- Doubled the amount of programming in 2 years

# Metrics



### Metrics

- With **24 playgrounds**, SFUSD adds 10% more playgrounds for San Francisco's kids
- With 45 schoolyards open on the weekends, SFUSD increases open space by 36 acres
- 2600 children participated in programs in FY 2022



# Budget





### **Current Costs**

Description of Services	Projections/Year
To open and close the gates, custodial services	\$ 341,228
Restrooms and handwashing sinks at 15 sites	\$ 44,460
2-4 hours of programming (basketball, soccer, arts, bike riding) at 15 sites	\$ 148,200
Program Management	\$ 66,054
Total	\$ 599,942





# 2.0 Experience By Site

Description of Services	Per Weekend	Per Year
To open and close the gates, custodial services	\$ 145	\$ 7,540
Restrooms and handwashing sinks	\$ 57	\$ 2,964
2-4 hours of programming (basketball, soccer, arts, bike riding)	\$ 190	\$ 9,880
Program Management	\$ 85	\$ 4,404
Total	\$ 477	\$ 24,788




