[Street Name Change - Sonora Lane to Vicha Ratanapakdee Way]

## Resolution changing the street name of Sonora Lane, between O'Farrell Street and Terra Anza Avenue, in the Anza Vista neighborhood, to "Vicha Ratanapakdee Way."

WHEREAS, On October 19, 2021, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 489-21, declaring the Board's intent to rename Sonora Lane, between O'Farrell Street and Terra Anza Avenue, to "Vicha Ratanapakdee Way," and directing the Department of Public Works to initiate the City's street naming procedures; and

WHEREAS, Sonora Lane is the existing name of the public right-of-way between O'Farrell Street and Terra Anza Avenue, and runs parallel to Anza Vista and St. Joseph's Avenues, and is perpendicular to O'Farrell Street and Terra Anza Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Sonora Lane is in the Anza Vista neighborhood and near what was the home of Mr. Vicha Ratanapakdee, and which remains the home of his family; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ratanapakdee was an 84-year-old immigrant from Thailand who was well known in the Anza Vista neighborhood for his hour-long walks each morning, a ritual that kept him vibrant and healthy during the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, On January 28, 2021, Mr. Ratanapakdee, while walking peacefully in the neighborhood, was suddenly and violently shoved to the pavement by an assailant, resulting in severe head injuries from which Mr. Ratanapakdee tragically died shortly after the attack; and

WHEREAS, Stop AAPI Hate, a California-based coalition, has recorded nearly 7,000 hate incidents involving Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders nationwide since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

Supervisors Stefani; Mandelman, Mar, Dorsey BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEREAS, Since Mr. Ratanapakdee's passing, his daughter has dedicated herself to working to ensure survivors of these attacks and their families are supported through city services, law enforcement, and the justice system; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ratanapakdee's daughter has also worked to amplify the voices of Asian Americans and the Thai and Southeast Asian communities through her participation in marches, rallies, and many #stopAAPIHate events; and

WHEREAS, Renaming Sonora Lane to "Vicha Ratanapakdee Lane" would commemorate and memorialize Mr. Ratanapakdee's death as a symbol of a movement towards equality, anti-discrimination, and solidarity with the Asian American and Pacific Islander Community, and as a reminder of the importance of peace among all peoples, in accordance with Mr. Ratanapakdee's deepest values; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works conducted a review and investigation of the proposed street name change as directed under Resolution No. 489-21, finding that the proposed street name does not exist in the City's current list of official street names, and therefore does not warrant objection under Public Works Code, Section 423, and further finding that, pursuant to the process for changing street names set forth in the "Establishing Street Names" bulletin posted on the Department's webpage, no City Agencies or fronting property owners object to the proposed name change; and

WHEREAS, On January 20, 2022, the Department of Public Works notified the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors that it had completed its investigation into the proposed renaming of Sonora Lane, the only segment of which runs between Terra Vista Avenue and O'Farrell Street, and the results of which investigation are on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. 210885, the file for this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, In compliance with the requirement of California Streets and Highways Code, Section 970.5, notice of a public hearing was posted at least 10 days prior to the hearing on this Resolution before the Land Use and Transportation Committee, in at least three public places along the street proposed to be affected by the renaming; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That pursuant to its authority under California Government Code, Section 34091.1 and California Streets and Highways Code, Sections 970.5 and 5026, the Board of Supervisors hereby renames Sonora Lane, between Terra Vista Avenue and O'Farrell Street, to "Vicha Ratanapakdee Way" to honor Mr. Ratanapakdee's legacy, and to make clear that the City and County of San Francisco stands with its Asian American Pacific Islander communities during this extraordinarily difficult time for those communities; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Municipal Transportation Agency to erect street signs in accordance with Transportation Code, Section 2.2, which signs should indicate both the new and the former names of the street affected by this Resolution—the new street name, "Vicha Ratanapakdee Way," in large letters and the former name, "Sonora Lane," in smaller letters above or beneath the new name—and such signs indicating the two street names shall remain posted for five years and then replaced with signs indicating only the new street name "Vicha Ratanapakdee Way;" and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That in adopting this legislation, the Board of Supervisors does not intend to effectuate any change in City department jurisdictional control over the public right-of-way to be renamed as "Vicha Ratanapakdee Way;" and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to promptly forward a copy of this Resolution to the County Surveyor in accordance with California Streets and Highways Code, Section 5026, and that the County Surveyor include the new street name on the Official Map of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Department of Public Works to add "Vicha Ratanapakdee Way" to the City's official list of street names.
