Brief History

- Since 2004, City consolidated contract for refuse collection services for City government facilities through the Office of Contract Administration
- Last sole source contract approved in 2014 for 6 years, NTE \$48M
- November 2020: new contract was before the Board but no action taken
- For continuity of refuse service, OCA entered into an interim contract covering Dec 2020 Nov 2021
 - o NTE: \$9.9M
 - o **Duration:** December 1, 2020 November 30, 2021
- Board approved contract extension in Nov. 2021
 - Current NTE: \$15.6M
 - Current Duration: December 1, 2020 June 30, 2022

Proposed Amendment - Overview of Major Provisions

- Duration: 2-year extension to June 30, 2024
- NTE: \$39.6M based on current utilization
- Scope: No change
- Continues favorable contract terms

Substantive change from previously introduced itemrequires continuance

• Rates: Today's rates adjusted by CPI in Year 1 (July '22 – June '23) and Year 2 (July '23 – June '24)

Next Steps

- June 2022: Issue solicitation for new contract (complete)
- November 2022: Evaluation complete, issue Conditional Notice of Intent to Award
- Winter 2022: CEQA process begins
- Spring 2023: DPH permitting (concurrent with CEQA)*
- June 2023: CEQA process complete*
- July 2023: Finalize contract
- September 2023 : BOS Approval
- September 2023: Execute contract
- Fall 2023 Spring 2024: Transition 375+ City sites to new contract (assumes 6-month process)*
