The grant period begins on the last date of signature after CAL FIRE and the grantee have both signed the completed grant agreement. CAL FIRE will notify grantees when work may begin and provide instruction for grant administration. Note that work includes any activity used for matching. Grantees will be held responsible for their contents. These 2021-2022 projects will be required to use the Modeling Tool to prospectively estimate the number of jobs supported by CCI projects.
