[Health Code - Patient Rates for FYs 2022-2023 and 2023-2024]

Ordinance amending the Health Code to set patient rates and rates for other services provided by the Department of Public Health, for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2022-2023 and 2023-2024.

Existing Law

San Francisco Health Code Section 128 sets forth the amounts to be charged for patient care provided by the Department of Public Health. Currently, Section 128 sets the rates for services rendered in fiscal years 2020-2021, 2021-2022, and 2021-2022.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would set the amounts to be charged for patient care provided by the Department of Public Health in fiscal years 2022-2023 (July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023) and 2022-2024 (July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024).

Background Information

The proposed rates are consistent with health care industry standards.
