Chapter 2A, Article V, of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Section 2A.93, to read as follows: SEC. 2A.93 FIRE; DEPUTY CHIEF S; OTHER EXECUTIVES. The Chief of the Fire Department shall have the power to appoint and to remove, at his or her the Chief's pleasure, two Deputy Chiefs of Department from among the members of the Department having the rank of Assistant Chief of Department or Battalion Chief; two Deputy Chiefs of Department one Deputy Chief from among the Emergency Medical Services or Community Paramedicine members of the Department with a rank of Captain, Section Chief, or above; and a Secretary to the Chief of the Department. Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

Mayor Breed; Supervisor Ronen BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
