I wanted to formally let you know that Recology has elected to not proceed with the award for Contract Proposal 68382 (Aggregate 2). The work was initially bid as an adjunct service to the Biosolids and Grit Hauling Services, so that in the event Recology was awarded the Aggregate 1 portion of the bid, the City would have one vendor to call for service.

It was a pleasure to work with you on this proposal but unfortunately our fully loaded hourly Union wage in conjunction with our high environmental standards imposed upon my truck fleet by the California Air Resources board's, Refuse Hauler Rule we find it hard to compete with Non-Union represented companies that are not held to the same environmental standards as we are. In the event that, the PUC cannot successfully negotiate with the lowest bidder for this Contract Proposal, Recology would be happy to reconsider its position regarding the Aggregate 2 work only if the Aggregate 1 services were awarded to Recology as well.
