

1 [Apply for Grant - United States Department of Housing and Urban Development - Continuum  
2 of Care Program - Not to Exceed \$54,655,600]

3 **Resolution approving the 2022 grant application for the United States Department of**  
4 **Housing and Urban Development Continuum of Care Program in an amount not to**  
5 **exceed \$54,655,600; and fulfilling the Board of Supervisors review and approval**  
6 **process for all annual or otherwise recurring grants of \$5,000,000 or more.**

8 WHEREAS, Under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”)  
9 2022 Continuum of Care (“CoC”) grant application, the City and County of San Francisco (the  
10 “City”) and participating nonprofit entities are eligible to submit funding applications for funds  
11 not to exceed \$54,655,600 to assist people experiencing homelessness; and

12 WHEREAS, The 2022 CoC Notice of Funding Opportunity (“2022 NOFO”) was  
13 released on August 1, 2022, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
14 Supervisors in File No. 220948; and

15 WHEREAS, During the San Francisco 2021 CoC competition, San Francisco and its  
16 nonprofits were awarded \$51,403,408 to support San Francisco’s community efforts to end  
17 homelessness; and

18 WHEREAS, HUD requires submission of the 2022 CoC application by September 30,  
19 2022, a copy of the application form is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File  
20 No. 220948; and

21 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Local Homeless Coordinating Board (“LHCB”) serves  
22 as the lead entity that oversees the CoC process and programs, including the creation of  
23 program priorities, funding categories, application guidelines, and scoring tools; and

24 WHEREAS, The LHCB plans to submit the consolidated application for a total amount

1 not to exceed \$54,655,600 of which an amount greater than \$5,000,000 passes through the  
2 Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing (HSH); and

3 WHEREAS, The LHCB has been meeting monthly to advise on the City's CoC  
4 processes and programs, including receiving community input and participation in the  
5 development of program priorities, application scoring criteria, and application guidelines and  
6 process; and

7 WHEREAS, The LHCB approves the 2022 application process, scoring criteria, and  
8 funding priorities for the 2022 application as demonstrated in the LHCB letter of support, a  
9 copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 220948; and

10 WHEREAS, Under San Francisco Ordinance No. 256-05, the appropriate City  
11 department shall submit to the Board of Supervisors a Resolution articulating its grant  
12 application, as well as funding categories, for all annual grant applications of \$5,000,000 or  
13 more; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco LHCB and HSH are authorized to submit a 2022  
15 CoC application for an amount not to exceed \$54,655,600.
