3	Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Morton Weisberg against the		
4	City and County of San Francisco for \$50,000; the lawsuit was filed on December 23,		
5	2020, in San Francisco Superior, Case No. CGC-20-588596; entitled Morton Weisberg v.
