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

[Extending the Term of Service for the Power Plant Task Force]

Resolution extending the termination date of the Power Plant Task Force to December 31, 2011.

WHEREAS, By Resolution 362-99, the Board of Supervisors created a Potrero Power Plant Citizens Advisory Task Force to advise the City and County of San Francisco regarding the sale, operation and maintenance of the Potrero Power Plant; and

WHEREAS, The Task Force was formed in response to the concerns of San Francisco residents about the impacts of the planned closure of the Hunters Point Power Plant and the sale of the Potrero Power; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors authorized the Task Force to provide the City with input on 1) issues which adversely affect the surrounding Bayview Hunters Point and Central Waterfront neighborhoods such as noise, construction, and harmful emissions, 2) power plant workers' safety issues, and 3) any other related issues deemed appropriate by the Task Force; and

WHEREAS, By Resolutions 1055-00, 139-01, 366-01, 879-01, 733-02, 119-04, 386-04, 807-05, 416-06, 100-08, and504-09, the Board of Supervisors has amended the appointment process, adjusted the membership of the Task Force, renamed it the "Power Plant Task Force" and extended its life so that it may advise the Board of Supervisors on power policy issues related to the potential construction of new power generating facilities in the Southeast portion of San Francisco, the closure of existing facilities, power demand management, and on energy policy for the City; and

WHEREAS, The Task Force continues to perform a valuable service to the City through its examination of issues of concern to San Francisco residents such as the City's Energy Resource Plan, the Trans Bay Cable Project, and the ongoing effort to close the entirety of Mirant Corporation's Potrero Power Plant; and

WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission is updating the Electricity Resource Plan in consultation with the Task Force; and

WHEREAS, The Potrero Power Plant has not yet permanently closed; and,

WHEREAS, The Task Force members represent a variety of community viewpoints on power plant issues and the City's energy policy and have developed expertise on these matters that can assist the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors extends the term of the Power Plant Task Force from December 31, 2010 to December 31, 2011.
