3	Resolution declaring January 4, 2011, Suzy Loftus Day in the City and County of San
4	Francisco.

6	WHEREAS, Suzy Loftus has served San Francisco as an Assistant District Attorney
7	since 2005; and
8	WHEREAS, Suzy has distinguished herself as one of the District Attorney's finest and
9	most dedicated prosecutors, having served on the office's Gun Specialist, Domestic Violence
10	Preliminary Hearings, and Elder Abuse teams as well as on the office's Executive Staff as
11	Chief of Policy; and
12	WHEREAS, Her passion for serving as a prosecutor grew out of her lifelong
13	commitment to protecting the most vulnerable in our community, and, to that end, she earned
14	a reputation as an uncompromising advocate for victims in court, whether they were young
15	women suffering abuse, elderly victims of fraud and neglect, or entire neighborhoods
16	struggling with gun violence; and
17	WHEREAS, In court, Suzy was known for her command of the law and her fidelity to it
18	In the Hall of Justice's criminal courtrooms, a prosecutor's reputation for integrity is
19	everything. Among the judges, her colleagues in the Police Department, and her opposing
20	counsel, Suzy is known for her honesty and for having unimpeachable integrity; and
21	WHEREAS, Suzy has a wonderful ability to connect with and honor victims of crime.
22	At first, many victims express fear or even distrust of law enforcement when they first come to
23	the District Attorney's Office or the Police Department. But because Suzy sees it as her
24	mission to fight for every victim, to listen to them and to honor their rights, she won many of
25	

them over and gave them back a little faith in the system. To this day, witnesses and victims from cases she handled years ago still call her to check in and to thank her; and

WHEREAS, Suzy has served as a mentor and friend to many of her fellow prosecutors, and is proud of her service on the office's Hiring Committee and her service as an Assistant Managing Attorney overseeing the office's newest attorneys in the Misdemeanor Trial Division; and

WHEREAS, When asked what she's most proud of, Suzy always has the same answer: her large, wonderful family. She and her husband, Tom Loftus, have three beautiful girls, Maureen, Vivian, and Grace. She is especially close with her mother and best friend, Maureen Roche. Despite being a "Super Mom" to three young girls and a full-time prosecutor, she still finds time to be a sister, best friend, and counselor to countless other friends and relatives from San Francisco to New York to Ireland; and

WHEREAS, Before becoming a prosecutor, Suzy worked for nearly a decade
supporting progressive candidates for office and causes all over America with a focus on
equal justice and public education. She was a founding staff member at the White House
Project, a group dedicated to electing more women to public office, the Issues Manager at the
Barbara Lee Family Foundation, and graduated from the Emerge Campaign Training
Program for Democratic women in 2009. She currently serves on the Board of Directors of

WHEREAS, In 2009, District Attorney Kamala D. Harris appointed Suzy to the office's Executive Staff as Chief of Policy, a position in which she oversaw the office's policy and programs, communications and public information staff and advised the District Attorney on

the San Francisco Women's Political Caucus; and

5	Special Assistant Attorney General in the California Department of Justice. She will serve as a senior advisor to the Attorney General and assist in advancing the new administration's
6 7	policies and priorities involving local law enforcement, prison reform, prosecuting white-collar
8	crime, and enforcing civil rights laws; now, therefore, be it
9	RESOLVED, That the members of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
10	San Francisco, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, January 4, 2011, as SUZY LOFTUS DAY in the
11	City and County of San Francisco, do convey the city's profound and sincere appreciation for
12	all of her efforts to keep our city safe, do congratulate her on her new assignment, and do
13	wish her success in her new assignment seeking justice for the people of the State of
14	California.
