WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has agreed to fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$1,164,614 for participation in a program, entitled "Medical Monitoring Project (MMP)," for the period of June 1, 2020, to May 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The MMP is a comprehensive population-based project to gather detailed information on human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)-infected patients receiving care in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Information collected through patient interview and medical chart abstraction will enable us to estimate resource needs for treatment and other services for people infected with HIV in San Francisco, as well as nationally; and

WHEREAS, Data from the project can document who is receiving care and provide population-based estimates of clinical characteristics for persons with HIV and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) in care; and

WHEREAS, This information can then be used to improve access to care and prevention by supporting funding requests for the Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resources Emergency Act, and by informing the HIV prevention community planning process; and

WHEREAS, A grant increase of \$108,790 from \$1,055,824 was approved for the period of June 1, 2020, through May 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received the award letters on August 19, 2020, for a project start date of June 1, 2020, and on August 25, 2021, for a project start date of June 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$11,580; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$1,164,614 from the CDC; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1.
