

This would also limit any our guests from contributing to any noise or traffic issues at other businesses in the area, or being exposed to crime, traffic and other safety issues, especially for international travelers.

The café would enjoy additional sales, and hence additional sales tax revenues for local government while limiting the potential impact on government services in our area. A better revenue stream also helps ensure job security and better earnings for our staff during a challenging economic time. Once the license is issued, our inventory would be ordered from designated licensed beverage wholesalers, the majority of which are also local businesses. This has a positive impact for our business and for the city in general.

For these reasons, we think that a resolution of public convenience and necessity would be justified. We respectfully request that the Board of Supervisors pass such a resolution in support of our application.
