WHEREAS, The President of the Board of Supervisors Shamann Walton has submitted a letter notifying the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the nomination of Jessica Campos to the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Code, Article XX, Section 5.200, and Section 10.100-367, and California Education Code, Sections 8499.3-8499.7, received by the Clerk of the Board on September 20, 2022; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby approve/reject the President of the Board of Supervisors' nomination for the appointment of Jessica Campos (residency requirement waived) to the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council, seat 12, succeeding Graham Dobson (term expired), must be a nominee of the President of the Board of Supervisors and represent one of the following categories: consumers, child care providers, discretionary, community representatives, or public agency representatives, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending March 19, 2024; and, be it

- FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:
 - 1. The membership of the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

1 2. Applicant Jessica Campos, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with 2 experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Child Care Planning and 3 Advisory Council. 3. The Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has attempted to fill the position, for 4 5 which Jessica Campos was nominated, with an individual who is City a resident and 6 who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Jessica Campos is qualified to 7 8 serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council. 9 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representatives who is a resident of San Francisco, who has the specific 10 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to 11 12 serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council at this time; and, be it 13 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement 14 for Jessica Campos, as is allowed in cases where no qualified City resident who is willing to 15 serve can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that otherwise requires 16 person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative 17 act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco. 18 19 20 21
