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13	WHEREAS, There is a continued need to provide behavioral health peer support
14	services, peer counseling, peer wellness services, and peer training; and
15	WHEREAS, DPH selected Richmond Area Multi-Services, Inc. (RAMS) to provide Peer
16	to Peer Services and a Peer Specialist Mental Health Certificate program through Request for
17	Qualifications (RFQ) 27-2020, issued on August 17, 2020, and Peer to Peer Linkage
18	programming through RFQ 43-2019, issued on December 18, 2019, and Wellness in the
19	Streets through Request for Proposals (RFP) 49-2018, issued on December 20, 2018, and an
20	Intensive Case Management Transition Support to Outpatient program through
21	RFQ 22-2018, issued on July 6, 2018; and
22	WHEREAS, DPH entered into an original agreement on July 1, 2021, following
23	RFQ 27-2020, to provide these behavioral health peer services for eighteen months, with the
24	term of July 1, 2021, through December 31, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$9,862,750;
25	and

1	WHEREAS, DPH wishes to amend the agreement to continue providing behavioral
2	health peer services, peer training and related services by extending the term by three and
3	one-half years, from December 30, 2022, through June 30, 2026, increasing the contract by
4	\$19,253,431 to reflect annual funding for each additional year, for a total contract amount not
5	to exceed \$29,116,181 and for a total agreement term of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2026;
6	and
7	WHEREAS, Section 9.118 of the Charter requires approval of the Board of Supervisors
8	for contracts requiring anticipated expenditures exceeding \$10 million; now, therefore, be it
9	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Public
10	Health and the Director of the Office of Contract Administration/Purchaser, on behalf of the
11	City and County of San Francisco, to execute Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with RAMS
12	to provide behavioral health peer services, peer training and service delivery evaluation, to
13	extend the term by three and one-half years, from December 30, 2022, through June 30,
14	2026, increasing the contract by \$19,253,431, for a total contract amount not to exceed
15	\$29,116,181, and for a total agreement term of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2026; and, be in
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of
17	Public Health to enter into any amendments or modifications to the contract, prior to its final
18	execution by all parties, that the Department determines, in consultation with the City
19	Attorney, are in the best interests of the City, do not otherwise materially increase the
20	obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of
21	the contract, and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and, be it
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the contract being fully executed
23	by all parties, the Director of Health and/or the Director of the Office of Contract
24	Administration/Purchaser shall provide the final contacts to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion

into the official File No. 221119.
