(7) No person under the age of twenty-one (21) shall sell, furnish, or deliver alcoholic beverages. (8) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257. (9) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. 


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
