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DMC-ODS Intergovernmental Agreement

- This five-year agreement between the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) replaces the expiring three-year Agreement No 19-96217, last approved by the Board of Supervisors on October 22, 2019 (File No.190943).
- This agreement reflects new Cal AIM (California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal) updates from DHCS. Cal AIM emphasizes care coordination, reduced documentation requirements, and payment reform and is a further advance of parity for substance use disorder (SUD) Medi-Cal benefits.
- This is a mandatory agreement between the State and each California County. The agreement includes state general fund dollars and is also the payment mechanism for Drug Medi-Cal Services.
- **This agreement includes terms and conditions for budgeted, allocated and fee for service SUDS Programs to continue to provide Drug Medi-Cal services and get reimbursed for up to \$248M over 5 years from July 2022 through June 2027.**
