Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Mayor Gavin Newsom established a reward fund of \$10,000 to be paid to any individual or individuals supplying information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the deaths of Mark Ashley. During the course of investigation of the death, a witness came forward with information leading to an arrest and conviction of the person responsible for the death of Mark Ashley.
