At its virtual meeting on Monday, November 7th, 2022, the Youth Commission took the following recommendation on File No. 221031:

1. Youth Commissioners voted to support Resolution reflecting the intent of the Board of Supervisors to establish a Pacific Islander Cultural District to commemorate historical sites, preserve existing spaces, and plan for thriving and vibrant communities to celebrate Pacific Islander culture in the Visitacion Valley and Sunnydale neighborhoods.
2. The Youth Commission recognizes that the small businesses in the parameters of the future Pacific Islander Cultural District will benefit greatly from the establishment of the Pacific Islander Cultural District
3. The historical analysis in the resolution was a contributing factor for the Youth Commission supporting this intent and is very impressed by the amount of research and data given to advocate on the establishment of the Pacific Islander Cultural District.
