WHEREAS, The California Legislature amended Section 101480 of the California Health and Safety Code, effective January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Such amendment requires the Board of Supervisors to grant authority to the Local Officer to enter into a remedial action agreement and oversee a remedial investigation or remedial action, or both, at a hazardous waste release site; and

WHEREAS, The California Health and Safety Code, Sections 101480 through 101490, define a Local Officer as the County Health Officer, City Health Officer, or County Director of Environmental Health now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Health Officer or the Health Officer's designee and the Department of Public Health's Director of Environmental Health Branch or the Director's designee to enter into remedial action agreements and oversee remedial investigations and actions, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code, Section 101480.
