Ordinance authorizing the Office of Economic & Workforce Development to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$238,000 from the United States Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration to fund the Green Jobs Workforce Development Training Project, and amending Ordinance No. 191-10 (Annual Salary Ordinance FY2010-2011) to reflect the addition of one (1) grant funded 1824 Principal Administrative Analyst at 0.5 FTE in FY2010-2011 in the Office of Economic and Workforce Development.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

## **Section 1. Findings**

The grant award from the United States Department of Labor Employment and Training Fund (DOL) to the Office of Economic and Workforce Development (OEWD) in the amount of \$238,000 is to support the Green Jobs Workforce Development Training Project, which provides job training, placement, and supportive services to San Francisco residents who are unable to participate in the Green Skills Academy because they do not meet the income requirements to qualify for the Workforce Investment Act; and

The grant award from the United States Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration to the Office of Economic and Workforce Development (OEWD) in the amount of \$238,000 is to support the Green Jobs Workforce Development Training Project.

### Section 2. Authorization to accept and expend grant funds.

The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of Economic & Workforce Development to retroactively accept and expend the Green Jobs Workforce Development Training Project Grant in the amount of \$238,000 from the United States Department of Labor (DOL) Employment and Training Administration (ETA) to provide job training, supportive services to, and job placement services to San Francisco residents who are unable to participate in the Green Skills Academy; and

The Board of Supervisors further authorizes the OEWD Director, or designee, to furnish additional information or assurances the DOL or ETA may request in connection with this grant, to execute any and all agreements or other documents, and to take any other steps necessary to accept, distribute and expend the grant funds.
