



Luke's Local Inc., in preparation for opening our third full-service grocery store within San Francisco at 580 Green St., has requested a TYPE 21 Off-Sale General License. We are applying for a transfer of an existing license. Our application was submitted with the SF ABC office on 9/13/22. We notified neighbors and surrounding businesses by sending out the required ABC mailers on 9/27/22 and posted required signage at the premises on 9/22/22, which will remain up for the 30-day posting period. Our proposed business hours at 580 Green St. will be 8am – 9pm, 7 days/wk.

Luke's Local is a full-service grocery store with our first neighborhood market in Cole Valley having been established in December of 2016 and our second at 2190 Union St in Cow Hollow in November of 2020. We offer a wide selection of affordable foods and grocery products, ready-made meals from our commissary kitchen, a full-service butcher and deli counter, local and organic produce, specialty cheese, and a grocery delivery service. Since the opening of our first neighborhood market we have become a hub for our community and a much-loved grocer within the Cole Valley community and now the Cow Hollow community. We hope to do the same within the North Beach community with the opening of our third location in February 2023 at 580 Green St.

We currently offer a well curated selection of Wine, Beer, and Spirits at Cole and Union St. and hope to continue this offering at Green St. We are a family friendly business and encourage responsible behavior from our customers as well as staff. Our staff are trained to follow all applicable laws and guidelines regarding the sale and non-consumption of alcohol products in or around the store. If granted, we expect approximately 10% of revenue to come from Alcohol sales with the remaining 90% coming from food products and household goods.

We pride ourselves in offering both specialty as well as common grocery products and being a one-stop shop for our customer's weekly grocery trips. We believe the convenience of being able to pick up your favorite bottle of wine along with a fresh baguette and prime cut of meat
