

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Integrating I-Tech International AIDS Education and Training
2 Center - \$20,682]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to retroactively accept and**
5 **expend a grant in the amount of \$20,682 from the University of California San**
6 **Francisco to participate in a program entitled “Integrating I-Tech International AIDS**
7 **Education and Training Center” for the period of April 1, 2010, through March 31, 2011.**

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9 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the University of Washington
10 supporting the Integrating I-Tech International AIDS Education and Training Center; and,

11 WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, UCSF has subcontracted with DPH in the
12 amount of \$20,682 for the period of April 1, 2010, through March 31, 2011; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, UCSF requires the City to
14 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
15 Board of Supervisors in File No. 110128; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
16 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

17 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
18 for two existing positions, one Senior Physician Specialist (Job Class 2232) at .05 FTE, and
19 one Manager I (Job Class 0922) at .05 FTE, for the period of April 1, 2010, through March 31,
20 2011; and,

21 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
22 receive notification of the contract until December 13, 2010, for a project start date of April 1,
23 2010; and,

24 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$2,216;
25 now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant retroactively
2 in the amount of \$20,682 from UCSF; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
4 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
5 be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
7 agreement on behalf of the City.
