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3	Resolution approving the Infrastructure Financing Plan for City and County of San
4	Francisco Infrastructure Financing District No. 1 (Rincon Hill Area).
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6	RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors (Board of Supervisors) of the City and
7	County of San Francisco (City), State of California that:
8	WHEREAS, On October 19, 2010, the Board of Supervisors adopted its "Resolution of
9	Intention to Establish Infrastructure Financing District" (Original Resolution of Intention to
10	Establish IFD), stating its intention to form the "City and County of San Francisco
11	Infrastructure Financing District No. 1 (Rincon Hill Area)" (IFD) pursuant to Government Code
12	Section 53395 et seq. (IFD Law); and
13	WHEREAS, The City intends to form the IFD for the purpose of financing certain public
14	improvements (Facilities) as further provided in the Resolution of Intention to Establish IFD;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, Also on October 19, 2010, the Board of Supervisors adopted its
17	"Resolution Ordering Preparation of Infrastructure Financing Plan", ordering preparation of an
18	infrastructure financing plan (Infrastructure Financing Plan) consistent with the requirements
19	of the IFD Law; and
20	WHEREAS, The Infrastructure Financing Plan includes an amended list of Facilities to
21	be financed by the IFD; the amended list does not include the Sailor's Union of the Pacific
22	Community Center or the Library Services; and
23	WHEREAS, The Infrastructure Financing Plan also proposed including an additional
24	property in the IFD, and incorporated an amended proposed boundary map; and
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WHEREAS, On January 4, 2011, the Board of Supervisors adopted its "Resolution
 Amending Public Hearing Date Relating to Infrastructure Financing District" (together with the
 Original Resolution of Intention to Establish IFD, the Resolution of Intention to Establish IFD),
 which amended the Original Resolution of Intention to Establish IFD to call for a public hearing
 on February 8, 2011; and

6 WHEREAS, As required by the IFD Law, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors mailed
7 a copy of the Resolution of Intention to Establish IFD to each owner of land within the
8 proposed IFD and each affected taxing entity (as defined in the IFD Law); and

9 WHEREAS, As further required by the IFD Law, the designated official of the City 10 prepared the Infrastructure Financing Plan so as to comply with the requirements of the IFD 11 Law, and sent it, along with any report required by the California Environmental Quality Act 12 (Division 13) (commencing with Section 2100) of the Public Resources Code) that pertains to 13 the proposed Facilities or the proposed development project for which the Facilities are 14 needed (CEQA Report), to (i) each owner of land within the proposed IFD and (ii) each 15 affected taxing entity; the designated official also sent the Infrastructure Financing Plan and 16 the CEQA Report to (i) the City's planning commission and (ii) the Board of Supervisors; and WHEREAS, The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors made the Infrastructure Financing 17 18 Plan available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, As required by the IFD Law, the Board of Supervisors, as the legislative body of the City, which is the only affected taxing entity which is proposed to be subject to the division of taxes pursuant the IFD Law, wishes to consider and adopt a resolution approving the Infrastructure Financing Plan; now, therefore, be it

1	Section 1. Findings. The foregoing recitals are true and correct. The Board of
2	Supervisors has received all of the information it is required to have received under the IFD
3	Law prior to adoption of this Resolution.
4	Section 2. Approval of Infrastructure Financing Plan. The Board of Supervisors, as
5	the legislative body of the City, which is the only affected taxing entity which is proposed to be
6	subject to the division of taxes pursuant the IFD Law, as further described in the Infrastructure
7	Financing Plan, hereby approves the Infrastructure Financing Plan, in the form on file with the
8	Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
9	Section 3. Direction to File this Resolution. This Resolution shall be filed with the
10	Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at or prior to the time of the public hearing for the proposed
11	IFD.
12	Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
