Motion finding that Miriam Zouzounis' proposal to apply for grants administered by the
Office of Economic and Workforce Development ("OEWD") and to seek assistance from
OEWD relating to the non-profit on whose Board she serves on are not incompatible
with the Statement of Incompatible Activities of the Small Business Commission, of
which she is a member, subject to conditions.
WHEREAS, Miriam Zouzounis is a member of the Small Business Commission
("SBC"), appointed by the Board of Supervisors, and is a Board Member of the Neighborhood
Business Alliance, a community merchant non-profit trade association; and
WHEREAS, Members of the Small Business Commission are subject to a Statement of
Incompatible Activities ("SIA") that guides OEWD employees and members of the SBC about
the kinds of activities that are incompatible with their public duties and therefore prohibited;
and
WHEREAS, Section 3.218 of the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code
authorizes City employees and officers to seek an Advance Written Determination ("AWD")
from their employer or appointing officer that a proposed activity is or is not incompatible with
the governing SIA; and
WHEREAS, An AWD that a proposed activity is not incompatible with the applicable
SIA provides the requestor with immunity from any subsequent enforcement action for
violation of the SIA if the material facts are as presented in the requestor's written submission;
and

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1	WHEREAS, Miriam Zouzounis submitted a request for an AWD confirming that the
2	following activities are not incompatible under the SBC's SIA: Applying for grants and loans
3	administered by OEWD to support the Neighborhood Business Alliance; and
4	WHEREAS, The SBC's SIA provides that no officer may serve as a member of the
5	Board of Directors of a nonprofit organization that applies for loans or grants administered by
6	OEWD, SBC or the Workforce Investment San Francisco Board; and
7	WHEREAS, Notwithstanding this prohibition, Miriam Zouzounis' proposed activities are
8	not incompatible with the SBC's SIA because the City and County aspires to a diversity of
9	representation on its Boards and Commissions, particularly encouraging members of the
10	BIPOC, Immigrant, LGBTQ+, Reentry and other underrepresented communities to serve on
11	their own time; and
12	WHEREAS, BIPOC, Immigrant, LGBTQ+, Reentry and other underrepresented
13	communities also experience significant barriers to accessing small business financial and
14	technical support, as well as pre-development, lease, capital tenant improvement and
15	acquisition funding, and having to choose between equitable access to small business grants,
16	loans or other forms of public assistance can be a disincentive to authentic and diverse
17	representation on the Small Business Commission; and
18	WHEREAS, Miriam Zouzounis does not receive compensation for her volunteer service
19	on the board of Neighborhood Business Alliance, which is a community merchant non-profit
20	trade association; now, therefore, be it
21	MOVED, That based on the information submitted, the Board of Supervisors finds that
22	the Proposed Activities are not incompatible with the SIA of the SBC, subject to the following
23	conditions:
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1	<ul> <li>Miriam Zouzounis will submit another AWD if the Neighborhood Business</li> </ul>
2	Alliance applies for additional grants or loans after two years of the adoption of
3	this Motion; and
4	<ul> <li>Miriam Zouzounis will not receive direct grant relief from OEWD or the</li> </ul>
5	Neighborhood Business Alliance or be compensated by Neighborhood Business
6	Alliance for her role as a Board Member.
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
