WHEREAS, The California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) has agreed to fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$6,000,000 for participation in a program, entitled "Proposition 47 Supporting Treatment & Reducing Recidivism (STARR) - Cohort III," for the period of September 1, 2022, through June 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, The DPH STARR program meets one of the most critical community care needs in San Francisco, providing additional residential treatment beds, outpatient case management, and wraparound support services for criminal justice-involved adults with co-occurring substance use disorder and mental health issues; and

WHEREAS, The overall goal is to reduce incarceration and recidivism by bolstering city-wide initiatives focused on jail diversion, recovery, and community re-entry; and WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and WHEREAS, The grant terms requires a minimum cost sharing of \$3,144,717; and WHEREAS, The cost sharing will be funded from the San Francisco City and County General Fund; and

WHEREAS, DPH will provide a report on the occupancy of this program, and the finding status of the twenty-two treatment beds no longer funded in the proposed grant agreement no later than May 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, DPH received the award notice on July 26, 2022, for a project start date of September 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received the award notice on July 26, 2022, for a project start date of September 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$6,000,000 from the BSCC; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1.
