11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13	Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Article XI of			
14	Chapter 5, and sections 5.102 and 5.103, to read as follows:			
15	SEC. 5.102. MEMBERSHIP.			
16	The Commission shall consist of 17 13 members. Twelve Nine of the members shall be			
17	appointed by the Board of Supervisors <u>to hold seats 1 through 9</u> and <u>five four</u> of the members			
18	shall be appointed by the Mayor to hold seats 10 through 13. Members of the Commission shall			
19	have the following qualifications as follows:			
20	(a) At least three women veterans. The Board of Supervisors shall appoint at least two			
21	members pursuant to this subsection; the Mayor shall appoint at least one member pursuant to this			
22	Subsection. Seat 1: must be a spouse, registered/certified domestic partner, or a widow/widower of a			
23	veteran who served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America;			
24	(b) Seats 2 and 10: must be women veterans; At least two members who served in the Armed			
25	Forces of the United States of America and who have a physical disability arising from that service, in

- 2 Board of Supervisors shall each appoint at least one member pursuant to this Subsection.
- 3 (c) *All members shall reside in the City and County of San Francisco, effective on the operative*
- 4 *date of this section. The Board of Supervisors may only waive this requirement by ordinance* <u>Seats 3</u>
- 5 and 11: must be members who served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America and who has
- 6 *a physical disability arising from that service, in accordance with the definitions applied in such cases*
- 7 *by the Veterans' Administration.*
- 8 (d) Seats 4-9 and 12-13: are not subject to the requirements set forth in subsections (a) through
  9 (c) above.
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## SEC. 5.103. ORGANIZATION AND TERMS OF OFFICE

- 12 (a) The term of each member of the Commission shall be four years; provided, however, 13 that the members first appointed shall, by lot, classify their terms so that three members shall serve a 14 one-year term, four members shall serve a two-year term, four members shall serve a three-year term and four members shall serve a four-year term. On the expiration of these and successive terms, their 15 16 successors shall be appointed for a four-year term in a manner similar to that described for the initial members. 17 18 (b) In the event a vacancy occurs during the term of office of any member, a successor shall be appointed for the unexpired term of the office vacated in a manner similar 19 20 to that described for the initial members. 21 (c) The Commission shall elect a chairperson from among its appointed members. The term of office as chairperson shall be for the calendar year or for the portion thereof 22 23 remaining after each such chairperson is elected.
- 24 (d) Services of the members of the Commission shall be voluntary and members will
   25 serve without compensation.

1	(e) Continuing Membership on the Commission. The clerk of the Commission, in consultation
2	with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, shall, upon the effective date of the ordinance in Board File
3	No, changing the number of the seats on the Commission, assign existing Commission
4	members, including members with expired terms serving as holdover appointees, to Seats 1-13 in
5	accord with the requirements of Section 5.102. Their terms of office shall be aligned with the terms of
6	office extant prior to the effective date of the aforementioned ordinance; with the understanding that
7	holdover appointees shall not thereby acquire any permanent or other special status. New
8	appointments made to Commission Seats 1 through 13 following the effective date of the
9	aforementioned ordinance shall be made in accordance with Section 5.102.
10	
11	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
12	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
13	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
14	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
15	
16	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
17	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
18	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
19	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
20	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
21	the official title of the ordinance.
