Enclosed for the Board of Supervisors' consideration and approval, please find a proposed Board Resolution requesting approval of the first amendment to the grant agreement with San Francisco-Marin Food Bank for the provision of Citywide Grocery Access. The new term will be from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 for a total not to exceed amount of \$11,228,328.

The amendment extends the term of the grant for an additional five months and increases funding to support this extension. The purpose of this grant is to distribute groceries to San Franciscans throughout the City focusing on high-need neighborhoods. Funding for this amendment is provided through City and County General Funds.
