Enclosed for the Board of Supervisors' consideration and approval, please find a proposed Board Resolution requesting approval of the second amendment to the grant agreement with Self-Help for the Elderly for Congregate Nutrition Services for Older Adults.

The purpose of this amendment is to provide additional funding to Self-Help for the Elderly that will allow them to continue to keep stride with the increased need for nutrition support in the community successfully. The demand for nutrition services in the community is elevated and food security continues to be a serious concern for older adults living in San Francisco. An additional part of the motivation for this amendment is to keep up with rising food costs and a significant decline in project income (i.e. consumers' voluntary contributions). Funding for this amendment is provided through a combination of Federal and State Funds, and City and County General Funds, including Dignity Fund.
