Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Victor Jimenez against the City and County of San Francisco for \$100,000; the lawsuit was filed on July 20, 2021, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-21-593613; entitled <u>Victor Jimenez v. City and County of San Francisco</u>; the lawsuit alleged property damage and personal injuries arising from a dangerous condition of public property, i.e., a sinkhole that

8 opened in the roadway underneath plaintiff's vehicle.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled <u>Victor Jimenez v. City and County of San Francisco</u>, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-21-593613 by the payment of \$100,000. The lawsuit involves alleged property damage and personal injuries arising from a dangerous condition of public property, i.e., a sinkhole that opened in the roadway underneath plaintiff's vehicle.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on July 20, 2021, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Victor Jimenez, plaintiff; City and County of San Francisco, defendant.
