PURPOSE FOR AMENDMENT: The purpose of the Grant amendment is to: The purpose of the Grant amendment is to: Increase the Grant amount for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 and FY 2023 to allow the Grantee to continue performing more of the same services as identified in Exhibit A and to reimburse the Grantee accordingly. Revise Exhibit B, Budget Detail and Payment Provision (in its entirety) and Exhibit E, Standards and Procedures to include the <u>Health and Safety Code (HSC) 120511</u> amended language regarding material support items for purposes consistent with this section. Update project representatives' information. Once the Grant Agreement has been fully executed, requests for modifications/changes thereafter to the existing Exhibit A, Scope of Work, do not require a formal amendment but must be agreed to in writing by both parties. The CDPH/Grantee Project Representatives are responsible for keeping records of approved modifications/changes. Such modifications/changes must be made at least 30 days prior to implementation. A formal written amendment is required when there is an increase or decrease in funding or a change in the term of the agreement.

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AMENDED GRANT AMOUNT: This amendment is to increase the grant for <u>FY 2022</u> by <u>\$193,137 and FY 2023 by \$193,137</u> and is amended to read: The maximum amount payable under this Grant shall not exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$978,948) <u>One Million, Three Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand, Two Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$1,365,222).</u>
