1	[Advanced Written Determination Regarding Statement of Incompatible Activities - Small Business Commission - Miriam Zouzounis]
2	Motion finding that Misiam Zourounial proposal to apply for grants administered by the
3	Motion finding that Miriam Zouzounis' proposal to apply for grants administered by the
4	Office of Economic and Workforce Development ("OEWD") and to seek assistance from
5	OEWD relating to the non-profit on whose Board she serves on are not incompatible
6	with the Statement of Incompatible Activities of the Small Business Commission, of
7	which she is a member, subject to conditions.

9	WHEREAS, Miriam Zouzounis is a member of the Small Business Commission
10	("SBC"), appointed by the Board of Supervisors, and is a Board Member of the Neighborhood
11	Business Alliance, a community merchant non-profit trade association; and
12	WHEREAS, Members of the Small Business Commission are subject to a Statement of
13	Incompatible Activities ("SIA") that guides OEWD employees and members of the SBC about
14	the kinds of activities that are incompatible with their public duties and therefore prohibited;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, Section 3.218 of the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code
17	authorizes City employees and officers to seek an Advance Written Determination ("AWD")
18	from their employer or appointing officer that a proposed activity is or is not incompatible with
19	the governing SIA; and
20	WHEREAS, An AWD that a proposed activity is not incompatible with the applicable
21	SIA provides the requestor with immunity from any subsequent enforcement action for
22	violation of the SIA if the material facts are as presented in the requestor's written submission;
23	and
24	
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WHEREAS, Miriam Zouzounis submitted a request for an AWD confirming that the
 following activities are not incompatible under the SBC's SIA: Applying for grants and loans
 administered by OEWD to support the Neighborhood Business Alliance; and

WHEREAS, The SBC's SIA provides that no officer may serve as a member of the
Board of Directors of a nonprofit organization that applies for loans or grants administered by
OEWD, SBC or the Workforce Investment San Francisco Board; and

WHEREAS, Notwithstanding this prohibition, Miriam Zouzounis' proposed activities are
not incompatible with the SBC's SIA because the City and County aspires to a diversity of
representation on its Boards and Commissions, particularly encouraging members of the
BIPOC, Immigrant, LGBTQ+, Reentry and other underrepresented communities to serve on
their own time; and

WHEREAS, BIPOC, Immigrant, LGBTQ+, Reentry and other underrepresented
communities also experience significant barriers to accessing small business financial and
technical support, as well as pre-development, lease, capital tenant improvement and
acquisition funding, and having to choose between equitable access to small business grants,
loans or other forms of public assistance can be a disincentive to authentic and diverse
representation on the Small Business Commission; and

WHEREAS, Miriam Zouzounis does not receive compensation for her volunteer service
on the board of Neighborhood Business Alliance, which is a community merchant non-profit
trade association; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That based on the information submitted, the Board of Supervisors finds that the Proposed Activities are not incompatible with the SIA of the SBC, subject to the following conditions:

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1	Miriam Zouzounis will submit another AWD if the Neighborhood Business
2	Alliance applies for additional grants or loans after two years of the adoption of
3	this Motion; and
4	 Miriam Zouzounis will not receive direct grant relief from OEWD or the
5	Neighborhood Business Alliance or be compensated by Neighborhood Business
6	Alliance for her role as a Board Member.
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REQUEST FOR ADVANCE WRITTEN DETERMINATION

Under section 3.218 of the San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code, each Department, Board, or Commission has adopted a Statement of Incompatible Activities ("SIA") that lists those outside activities that are inconsistent or incompatible with the duties of the officers and employees of the Department, Board, or Commission.
