Resolution supporting California State Assembly Rill No. 12 Security Denos

[Supporting California State Assembly Bill No. 12 (Haney) - Security Deposits]

Resolution supporting California State Assembly Bill No. 12, Security Deposits, authored by Assembly Member Matt Haney, to limit the maximum amount of rental security deposits at one month's rent.

WHEREAS, Rental costs in California continue to rise and the average rent in San Francisco ranges from \$3550 for a one-bedroom apartment to \$5000 for a two-bedroom apartment; and

WHEREAS, The current California Law allows landlords to charge two times the rent and in some cases three times the monthly rent for a security deposit; and

WHEREAS, That means in San Francisco, renters may need to pay as much as \$12,000 or \$15,000 for their security deposit in order to move in; and

WHEREAS, This high amount for security deposits creates a huge barrier for renters by causing some renters to borrow from predatory lenders or go in debt in order to access housing; and

WHEREAS, When renters cannot afford a security deposit, they may be forced to stay in crowded, insufficient, or even unsafe living situations and some may remain unhoused as a result; and

WHEREAS, While inflation has increased the cost of repairs for wear and tear on apartments, it remains far below the increase in the costs of security deposits due to skyrocketing rents; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill No. 12 (AB 12), introduced by Assembly Member Matt Haney, will limit the maximum amount for rental security deposits at one month's rent; and

WHEREAS, AB 12 will have no effect on potential-liability as landlords will still be able to seek damages from tenants who are responsible for harm to the property that exceeds the amount of the security deposit; and

WHEREAS, California passed a law with bipartisan support to set the maximum amount for security deposits for military service members at one month's rent; and

WHEREAS, If AB 12 passes, California will be the twelfth state in the country, joining states such as New York, Kansas, Hawaii, and Alabama, to limit security deposits to only one month's rent; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco recognizes the housing affordability challenges that have been rising over the last decade and the barriers to accessing housing; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby supports California Assembly Bill No. 12 and urges the California State Legislature to pass this bill in order to remove barriers to housing for all California renters; and, be it
