Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Works to apply for grant funds in the amount up to, but not to exceed, \$12,600 from the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, Tire-Derived Product Grant Program for the purpose of installing rubber sidewalks and preserving mature trees.

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, to administer various Grant Programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, The grant funds can only be used to purchase materials and does not provide for indirect costs, and



MERCONECON DESCRIBITION

The San Francisco Department of Public Works proposes to replace approximately 2,800 sq ft of damaged concrete sidewalks with tire-derived products, specifically rubbersidewalks, along Potrero Avenue in San Francisco. Presently, there are more than 6,029 City-maintained trees where sidewalk maintenance has been deferred. Of these locations, DPW has identified several mature tree wells in need of sidewalk repair within the Southeast sector, one of San Francisco's most economically disadvantaged communities. Since 2005 DPW has addressed environmental inequalities within in this district by planting over 1,000 new trees through the Mayor's Trees for Tomorrow initiative. The installation of rubbersidewalks at mature existing trees within the Southeast sector continues this effort and will help to reduce tree losses due to root removal for sidewalk repair and preserve our urban forest.
