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Resolution authorizing the Tax Collector to sell, at public auction, certain parcels of tax-defaulted real property.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Tax Collector has complied with all the statutory prerequisites for selling tax-defaulted property at internet auction, and each of the parcels of real property listed on the attached list of Tax-Defaulted Property Subject to Impending Tax Sale has been duly entered on the Tax Collector's roll of tax-defaulted real property for longer than five years; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Tax Collector shall research the physical characteristics and ownership history for each parcel on the attached list using property information available from the Assessor and the Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Tax Collector shall expend additional resources to identify and notify parties of interest for any parcel on the auction list, including skip tracing which typically involves a search of publicly available and proprietary databases, city/county and other governmental records, and the internet, used by our collections staff to recover delinquent obligations to the City; and

WHEREAS, The Tax Collector shall post a physical notice on any occupied parcel, and on any physically accessible vacant parcel for whom the certified mail to the owner is returned; and

WHEREAS, To bring additional resources to taxpayers at risk of losing their properties to tax auction, the Tax Collector has referred six parcels to the City Attorney's Code Enforcement Team, six parcels to Homeownership SF, five parcels to the Assessor, five parcels to the Public Utilities Commission, three parcels to the Sheriff's Office, two parcels to

1	Adult Protective Services, one parcel to the Rent Board, and one parcel to the Mayor's Office
2	of Housing and Community Development; now, therefore, be it
3	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Tax Collector is hereby directed to advertise and
4	sell each of the parcels listed on the attached List of Tax-Defaulted Property Subject to
5	Impending Tax Sale in the manner provided by the California Revenue and Taxation Code in
6	Division I, Part 6, including but not limited to the minimum bid procedures authorized by
7	Section 3698.6(c); and the Tax Collector is further directed to add the cost of advertisement
8	and sale of the herein described property to the minimum price to be collected from the
9	parcels offered for tax sale; and, be it
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Tax Collector is authorized to sell all
11	properties listed on the attached List of Tax-Defaulted Property Subject to Impending Tax
12	Sale below the minimum bid amount, if such properties cannot first be sold at the minimum
13	bid amount proposed at the sale; and, be it
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Tax Collector is authorized to notify
15	any new parties of interest in accordance with Section 3701 and reoffer any parcel that
16	remains unsold within 90 days.
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
