[Administrative Code - Health Service System Eligibility for Members of New Board and Commission]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to provide that members of the Homelessness Oversight Commission and Refuse Rate Board are eligible for health insurance coverage through the San Francisco Health Service System.

Existing Law

Section 16.700 of Chapter 16 of the Administrative Code currently authorizes members of certain City boards and commissions to be eligible to participate in the Health Service System.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would add the Homelessness Oversight Commission and the Refuse Rate Board to the authorized list of City boards and commissions, members of whom would be eligible to participate in the Health Service System. The proposed ordinance would also make conforming changes to the names of boards and commissions that were already on the list.
