


### PURPOSE OF INDIA BASIN WATERFRONT PARK

India Basin Waterfront Park project connects 900 Innes Avenue with two already existing parks, India Basin Shoreline Park and India Basin Open Space, to build new 10-acre waterfront park that is meaningful, equitable, and essential to the health of San

Francisco's southeast communities.

## PARK PRIORITIES

- Address decades of environmental contamination from boat building and repair activities
- Create inspiring and amenity-rich waterfront parks that build community capacity and are reflective of the Bayview community
- Create a resilient, healthy, and adaptive shoreline and community

## **CURRENT STATUS**

#### Project is broken into 3 phases:

- Remediation (Phase 1) complete
- Park Development 900 Innes (Phases 2) in progress
- Park Development India Basin Shoreline Park (Phase 3) future

The third and final phase is the renovation of the existing India Basin Shoreline Park.

Construction is expected to begin following the 900 Innes Park Development project in July 2024 and finish in July 2026. Construction is estimated at \$60M

#### The renovation of SHORELINE PARK will include:

- Cookout terrace with grills
- 2 Basketball courts
- New Playground and adult fitness area New public restroom
- Gathering and observation decks Boathouse with Boat launch Public access pier/dock
- Increased wetlands and renovated shoreline for habitat
