12	discharges from the City's Oceanside and Southeast Water Pollution Control Plants violated
13	National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits and state laws; and
14	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission recommends settling the
15	claim by paying \$236,500; now, therefore, be it
16	RESOLVED, That under Administrative Code, Section 10.22, the Board of Supervisors
17	authorizes the City Attorney to settle and compromise the claim by paying \$236,500.
