

1 [Amending Board Rules of Order - Amending Board Rule 3.25 and Adding Board Rule 3.32 to
2 Establish a Homelessness and Behavioral Health Select Committee]

3 **Motion amending the Board Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors by adding**
4 **Board Rule 3.32 to establish a Homelessness and Behavioral Health Select Committee;**
5 **and amending Board Rule 3.25 to include the new Committee as a fiscal committee.**
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7 WHEREAS, Board Rule 3.30 allows the Board, by Motion, to create Select Committees
8 after such Motion has been referred to the Rules Committee for public hearing and
9 recommendation to the Board, and except as provided in Rule 3.31, each Select Committee
10 shall consist of three Supervisors and the establishing Motion for each Select Committee shall
11 specify: a) a clear, simple, narrow, single statement of purpose, and b) a termination date or a
12 period of time during which the committee shall be in operation, which time shall commence
13 upon the appointment of its membership; now, therefore, be it

14 MOVED, Pursuant to Board Rule 3.30, that the Board of Supervisors of the City and
15 County of San Francisco hereby amends its Rules of Order to amend existing Rule 3.25 and
16 create a new Rule 3.32, as follows:

17 **3.25. Fiscal Committees.** In accordance with Administrative Code Section 2.6-3
18 concerning fiscal impact, the Government Audit and Oversight Committee, the Budget and
19 Finance Committee, the Budget and Appropriations Committee, ~~and~~ the Youth, Young Adult,
20 and Families Committee, and the Homelessness and Behavioral Health Select Committee shall each
21 be a “fiscal committee” of the Board and the other committees of the Board, solely for the
22 purpose of considering grants to the City within their subject areas, shall also be considered
23 “fiscal committees.”

24 **3.32. Homelessness and Behavioral Health Select Committee.** *The Homelessness and*
25 *Behavioral Health Select Committee shall be referred legislation and requests for hearings concerning*

1 the coordinated efforts of City Departments and State and Federal Agencies tasked with addressing the
2 City's response to homelessness and implementation of behavioral health interventions and treatment,
3 including fiscal matters with direct and exclusive fiscal impact on homeless individuals, service
4 providers, and medical and behavioral health treatment facilities that are not part of the annual budget
5 appropriation process. When the subject matter of legislation concerns these subjects and overlaps
6 with the scope of other committees, the President shall determine and designate the legislation. The
7 Select Committee shall consist of three members of the Board of Supervisors designated by the
8 President. This Select Committee shall terminate on January 7, 2025.

9 FURTHER MOVED, After the termination of the Select Committee, the Board directs the Clerk
10 of the Board to remove reference to the Select Committee from Rule 3.25 and remove Rule 3.32 in its
11 entirety from the Rules of Order.

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
