Motion amending the Board Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors by adding Board Rule 3.32 to establish a Homelessness and Behavioral Health Select Committee; and amending Board Rule 3.25 to include the new Committee as a fiscal committee.

WHEREAS, Board Rule 3.30 allows the Board, by Motion, to create Select Committees after such Motion has been referred to the Rules Committee for public hearing and recommendation to the Board, and except as provided in Rule 3.31, each Select Committee shall consist of three Supervisors and the establishing Motion for each Select Committee shall specify: a) a clear, simple, narrow, single statement of purpose, and b) a termination date or a period of time during which the committee shall be in operation, which time shall commence upon the appointment of its membership; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, Pursuant to Board Rule 3.30, that the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby amends its Rules of Order <u>to amend existing Rule 3.25</u> and create a new Rule 3.32, as follows:

3.25. Fiscal Committees. In accordance with Administrative Code Section 2.6-3 concerning fiscal impact, the Government Audit and Oversight Committee, the Budget and Finance Committee, the Budget and Appropriations Committee, and the Youth, Young Adult, and Families Committee, and the Homelessness and Behavioral Health Select Committee shall each be a "fiscal committee" of the Board and the other committees of the Board, solely for the purpose of considering grants to the City within their subject areas, shall also be considered "fiscal committees."

3.32. Homelessness and Behavioral Health Select Committee. The Homelessness and

Behavioral Health Select Committee shall be referred legislation and requests for hearings concerning

the coordinated efforts of City Departments and State and Federal Agencies tasked with addressing the City's response to homelessness and implementation of behavioral health interventions and treatment, including fiscal matters with direct and exclusive fiscal impact on homeless individuals, service providers, and medical and behavioral health treatment facilities that are not part of the annual budget appropriation process. When the subject matter of legislation concerns these subjects and overlaps with the scope of other committees, the President shall determine and designate the legislation. The Select Committee shall consist of three members of the Board of Supervisors designated by the President. This Select Committee shall terminate on January 7, 2025.

FURTHER MOVED. After the termination of the Select Committee, the Board directs the Clerk of the Board to remove reference to the Select Committee from Rule 3.25 and remove Rule 3.32 in its entirety from the Rules of Order.
