Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment for the City and County of San Francisco to apply for funding from the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CalFire) as provided through Propositions 40 and 84 for a project to plant fruit bearing trees on appropriate City land.

[Apply for Department of Forestry and Fire Protection Grant for Fruit Bearing Trees]

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of California in cooperation with the California State Legislature has enacted Propositions 40 and 84, which provide funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for urban forestry programs; and,

WHEREAS, the State Department of Forestry and Fire Protection has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary procedures governing application by local agencies and non-profit organizations under the program, and,

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the State Department of Forestry and Fire Protection require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of application before submission of said application to the State; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of the Environment for the City and County of San Francisco has been tasked with overseeing Urban Forest issues the City through the Urban Forest Council; and,

WHEREAS, based on the positive evaluation by CalFire of a project concept paper submitted by the Department of the Environment for the City and County of San Francisco to CalFire, it has been invited to submit a proposal to CalFire to secure funding to plant fruit bearing trees on appropriate city property, and,

WHEREAS, a project of this type will help the City enhance its Urban Forest, as well as provide food security; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant will enter into an agreement with the State of California to carry out an urban forestry project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco approved the filing of an application for "Propositions 40 and 84" grant program funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco certifies that said applicant has or will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco certifies that funds under the jurisdiction of San Francisco are available to begin the project; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco certifies that said applicant will expend grant funds prior to March 30, 2013.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco appoints the Department of the Environment as agent of the City of San Francisco to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, etc., which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
