Ordinance authorizing the Department of Technology to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$7,931,632 from the U.S. Department of Commerce through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Pub. L. 111-5) Broadband Technology Opportunities Program for Sustainable Broadband Adoption Training and Services, and amending Ordinance No. 191-10 (Annual Salary Ordinance FY 2010-2011) to reflect the addition of two (2) grant-funded positions for the Department of Aging and Adult Services in Class 1823 Senior Administrative Analyst, and four (4) grant-funded positions for the Department of Technology as follows: one (1) position in Class 1823 Senior Administrative Analyst; one (1) position in Class 1844 Senior Management Assistant; one (1) position in Class 1766 Media Production Technician; and one (1) position in Class 1769 Media Production Supervisor.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Pub. L. 111-5) ("ARRA") was signed by President Obama on February 17, 2009 and provided more than \$7,000,000,000 for broadband access and adoption. To date, the Department of Commerce's National Telecommunications and Information Administration ("NTIA") has awarded 223 Broadband Technology Opportunities Program ("BTOP") grants totaling over \$4,000,000,000.

In March of 2010, the Department of Technology applied for three BTOP grants, one each for Comprehensive Community Infrastructure, Public Computing Centers, and Sustainable Broadband Adoption ("SBA").

On September 27, 2010, the NTIA announced a BTOP grant award to the Department of Technology for SBA training and services for \$7,931,632. The City and County of San Francisco and its nonprofit partners will provide \$2,162,727 in matching funds, in-kind contributions for staff time, volunteer trainers/coordinators, and funding for computer and digital media equipment. The federal funding awarded by this grant includes \$636,836 in indirect charges.

Many San Francisco residents face digital inclusion challenges. While San Francisco enjoys generally high rates of technology adoption, this is not true among the City's economically and socially vulnerable populations. Less than 42% of the City's seniors and only 41% of the City's lowest income residents subscribe to broadband services.

The Board of Supervisors has recognized the critical link between closing this digital divide and the economic prosperity and quality of life of San Francisco residents. On November 16, 2010, the Board adopted Resolution 554-10, which set a goal to achieve broadband Internet access for 90% of San Franciscans by 2015, with a focus on connecting seniors and low income households.

The SBA grant will help achieve that goal, by funding four distinct programs that will work in concert to improve broadband adoption rates of the target groups by promoting broadband awareness and benefits: (1) Department of Aging and Adult Services programs for seniors and adults with disabilities; (2) Department of Technology "Public Broadband Space" digital media programs; (3) Department of Children Youth and Their Families program for atrisk youth and low-income families to obtain access to sustainable broadband services; and (4) City College of San Francisco in-home business skills training.

Through instruction in the value and benefits of broadband and access to specialized broadband services provided by nonprofit community partners, the SBA grant award will reduce economic and social isolation, open up windows of opportunity for accessing online services, and allow vulnerable populations to explore employment options and expand social interaction and health promotion resources. The grant will also provide a unique opportunity for advancing multi-media innovation and its economic potential, by providing training in digital media skills and operating home-based businesses for youth, the unemployed and low income residents in the City.

Section 2. Authorization to accept and expend grant funds.

The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Department of Technology to accept and expend \$7,931,632 in ARRA BTOP grant funds from the U.S. Department of Commerce, and further authorizes the Department of Technology to execute any documents required for the implementation of these grants, including amendments, augmentations or extensions thereof.

Section 3. Grant funded positions.

The City's Departments of Technology; Aging & Adult Services; and Children, Youth & Families, along with City College, Bay Area Video Coalition and key partners in the nonprofit, educational, and for-profit sectors, will provide broadband-oriented training and services to seniors, adults with disabilities, low-income and ESL youth, and other economically and socially vulnerable groups.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL ASAP USERS

The Financial Management Service (FMS) is developing Release 2.0 of the Automated Standard Application for Payments Internet application, ASAP.gov. Targeted for December 5, 2005 implementation, Release 2.0 will introduce a new web-based online Recipient Organization (Recipient) enrollment process that will allow Recipients to complete their own enrollment using ASAP.gov.

Under Release 2.0, Recipients must have a Data Universal Number System (DUNS) number and Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) to enroll in ASAP.gov. DUNS and TIN are already required at the time of the grant application and Federal Agencies will be required to provide this information to start the enrollment of a Recipient in ASAP.gov. FMS is working with existing Recipients to ensure that all have identified their DUNS and TIN. We will notify Federal Agencies of any Recipients that fail to provide this information prior to Release 2.0 as it will impact a Recipient's ability to access ASAP.gov.

While Release 2.0 will be implemented in December 2005, users will not see the new functionality until February 6, 2006. In December 2005 and January 2006, FMS will be granting access to Recipient Organization officials who have new roles in the ASAP.gov enrollment process. Federal Agencies will also have a new role in Release 2.0, which is needed to initiate Recipient enrollments. FMS will be contacting the Agencies to complete the enrollment of users for this new role during December and January. The new roles for both Recipient Organizations and Federal agencies are described below.

To prepare for Release 2.0, user access via the legacy ASAP dial-up method will be discontinued on October 31, 2005. This means that your access to ASAP using the CQ software or AT&T van connection will be terminated on October 31st and all users must use ASAP.gov. If you or anyone in your office is still using legacy ASAP access, you should begin using ASAP.gov immediately. Introduction

As stated in the Notice of Funds Availability (NOFA) for State Broadband Data and Development Grants (RIN 0660-ZA29), any grant awarded under the State Broadband Data and Development Program is subject to the applicable regulations and statues regarding reporting on Recover Act funds.

FederalReporting.gov is the central government-wide data collection system for Federal Agencies and Recipients of Federal awards under Section 1512 of the Recovery Act. Recipients will access FederalReporting.gov in order to fulfill their reporting obligations. 

Submitted reports will not be editable by prime recipients or delegated sub-recipients during this time period unless notified by the Federal agencies. The Federal agencies will perform a data quality review. The Federal agencies will notify the recipients and delegated sub-recipients of any data anomalies or questions through the www.FederalReporting.gov solution.

No later than 30 days following the end of the quarter, detailed recipient reports are made available to the public on the www.Recovery.gov website. Federal agencies may also post recipient information on their respective websites after the data has been posted on the www.Recovery.gov website.
