4	and County of San Francisco for \$3,000,000; the lawsuit was filed on September 30,

8	settlement are City to waive \$33,607.51 offset for unpaid Zuckerberg San Francisco

15	payment of \$3,000,000 and City to waive \$33,607.51 offset for unpaid Zuckerberg San
