WHEREAS, The Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI), through Heluna Health (HH) as a pass-through entity, has agreed to fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$134,528 for participation in a program, entitled "Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI)," for the period of October 1, 2021, to September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, PCORI is funding a study to compare two mobile health technologies for supporting pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) use among cisgender men, transgender men, and transgender women; and

WHEREAS, Individuals in three sites in the US (San Francisco, Miami, Washington, DC) will be enrolled in this study to compare the impact of these mobile health strategies on PrEP adherence and continuation, satisfaction with medical care, and patient engagement in a 12-month study; and

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and WHEREAS, A grant increase of \$34,645 from \$99,883 was approved for the period of October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received the award on April 27, 2022, for a project start date of October 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$26,906; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$134,528 from the PCORI through HH; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is retroactively authorized to enter into the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Agreement being fully-executed by all parties, the Director of Health shall provide the final Agreement to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
