**Ordinance appropriating \$10,000,000 from the General Reserve for the following uses: \$4,000,000 to the Office of Economic and Workforce Development for nonpolice ambassadors for areas of the Tenderloin that currently lack such coverage, \$3,000,000 to the Office of Economic and Workforce Development for small business safety and security grants, and \$3,000,000 to the Department of Public Health to launch the Tenderloin Street Dealing Intervention Program in Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2023.**
