3	Resolution determining that the premise-to-premise transfer of a Type-20 off-sale
4	beer and wine liquor license to Mainstay Markets, to do business as Mainstay
5	Markets located at 655-22 Street (District 10), will serve the public convenience or
6	necessity of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with California
7	Business and Professions Code, Section 23958.4; and requesting that the
8	California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the
9	issuance of the license.

11	WHEREAS, Mainstay Markets is seeking the premise-to-premise transfer of a
12	Type-20 off-sale beer and wine liquor license to do business at 655-22 Street
13	(District 10); and
14	WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
15	zoned and recommends approval; and
16	WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero protests and zero letters of
17	support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business
18	and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of
19	Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and
20	WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the
21	following: 1) Petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort
22	to prevent the loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as
23	depicted on the ABC-253; and 2) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining
24	free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control, as depicted
25	on ABC-253; now, therefore, be it

1	RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code
2	Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
3	hereby determines that the premise-to-premise transfer of a Type-20 off-sale beer and
4	wine liquor license to Mainstay Markets, to do business as Mainstay Markets located
5	at 655-22 Street, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County
6	of San Francisco; and, be it
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
8	San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police
9	Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
10	Control issue the license with those conditions.
