I also asked the Mayor to officially resign as deploying this device can cause serious injury and death. At its current location, it is turned on 24/7/365 which is outside the authorized scope.

These rules were established if I'm correct by the Rules Committee with multiple meetings from July

through November 2022.

Please forward to the Board of Supervisors as well as this is clearly outside the scope of the rules, outside the scope of deployment. The LRAD has a typical range of approximately 5 plus miles. From this location, it would cover a large swath of area inside San Francisco and could be responsible as a contributing factor in overdoses, violence and road rage and violence.
