Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the actions entitled Charlene Tuchman v. 3800

Washington, LLC, et al. and Ellen Rothmann as successor in interest to Charlene Tuchman v. 3800 Washington, LLC, et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Case Nos. CGC-21-590596 and CGC-22-598595 for the payment to the City of \$250,000 and payment to Plaintiff of \$250,000 by 3800 Washington LLC. The lawsuits involve personal injuries arising from personal injuries sustained on a City sidewalk.

Section 2. The above-named actions were filed in San Francisco Superior Court on March 24, 2021 and March 9, 2022, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiffs: Charlene Tuchman and Ellen Rothmann as successor in interest to Charlene Tuchman; Defendants/Cross-Defendants/Cross-Complainants: 3800 Washington LLC and City and County of San Francisco.
