## **RESOLUTION NO. 109-23**

[Supporting California State Assembly Bill No. 1505 (Rodriguez) - \$250,000,000 Seismic Retrofitting Program for Soft Story Multifamily Housing]

Resolution supporting California State Assembly Bill No. 1505, introduced by Assembly Member Freddie Rodriguez, maintaining \$250,000,000 in funding for a state Seismic Retrofitting Program for Soft Story Multifamily Housing in California.

WHEREAS, On February 6, 2023, in Turkey, two major earthquakes left over 50,000 people dead and collapsed or damaged more than 160,000 buildings; and

WHEREAS, The aftermath of this tragedy is likely to reveal that many of the collapsed buildings suffered from the same vulnerabilities as certain older building types in Californiasuch as soft-story buildings; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors, under the leadership of Mayor Edwin M. Lee, passed in 2013 a mandatory soft story Ordinance for certain multi-family housing of more than 5-units that today has 90% of all buildings in the program in compliance; and

WHEREAS, According to the 2010 CAPSS report, 34% of the city's residential housing stock is 3-4 unit wood-frame residences and the CAPSS report mentions "a mandatory program addressing these [3-4 unit wood-frame] buildings should begin as soon as progress on seismic upgrades to the five unit buildings progresses to the point that the program can be expanded, about five years from the present;" and

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
supports AB 1505, setting aside \$250,000,000 for a statewide soft-story program; and, be it
FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
Francisco directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to transmit a copy of this Resolution to
Assembly Member Freddie Rodriguez and to Assembly Members Matt Haney and Phil Ting
and Senator Scott Wiener.
